

Brexit update 16/7/20

UK Government publishes Border Operating Model

On Monday 16th July 2020 the UK Government has published its full [Border Operating Model](#) for freight movements between Great Britain and the EU after the transition period ends on December 31st 2020. It covers both imports and exports, and in conjunction with its publication they have also issued individual step-by-step guides for [importing](#) and [exporting](#).

We would like to advise our clients that if they have not done so already to take the following steps in preparation for the changes: -

- Obtain an Economic Operators Registration and Identification (EORI) number.

- Find the correct commodity codes for the products you export, and check if the commodity codes for goods you import would mean they are liable for duty if no trade deal with the EU is agreed.

- Ensure that the [Incoterms](#) that you agree with your suppliers and/or clients are correct and that you understand your liabilities under those terms.
